EPEA invites the press to a presentation at the Exhibition "Waste to Energy" in Bremen on the topic:

Waste Incineration Plants: Not an Alternative for Intelligent Material Flow Management

The use of waste as a fuel is not reasonable

The chief scientist of EPEA Internationale Umweltforschung, Prof. Michael Braungart, will present the following:

Instead of *real* waste material recycling, which would allow materials to be well preserved, waste is being thermally treated in an ever increasing way – incineration. As a result, valuable materials that can be used again as secondary raw materials are lost. This problem will be discussed at the exhibition, "Waste to Energy" held in the Bremer PresseClub facility in Bremen, Germany.

Genuine material recycling is necessary because the problem of waste will eventually become larger than the energy problem. Although the use of waste for fuel is acceptable for a limited time, this concept cannot solve the fundamental problems of waste, material and energy in the long term.
